
Area 3: Alley way perpendicular to Temple's main axis, leading towards the inner squatters / urban village.

Ownership: Renters (2 to 6 years)

Physical Descriptions:

- The width of the alleyway is between 800 to 900mm only, barely a meter.
- Only 2 doors, side by side, were present in this narrow alleyway.
- At night, there was no street light along this alley way at all.
- The width of the alleyway was defined by the width of the existing temple, from center to the edge.





Initial Observations by researcher:

- Almost all local use this alley way as a short cut and not the way route.
- Only people walking, on bicycles or motorcycle could go through.
- Children hardly use this space to play together either.
- Spatial negotiation phenomenon are not evident here (No grey area)

Researcher's initial analysis:

Emergence of spatial negotiation phenomenon is affected by the physical attribute of the space. Non-conducive space to gather, or having active frontage of entrance door to a room unit, doesn't propagate interaction.
